

DIRECTIONS:

FROM WEST – ROUTE 80 & 46

Route 80 East to 46 East to Route 3 East – to Bloomfield Ave. exit
**SEE BELOW

FROM NORTH – GARDEN STATE PARKWAY

Parkway South to exit 153 ON LEFT (Route 3 EAST) after toll you
will be on Route 3, take the next exit - Bloomfield Ave - **SEE
BELOW

FROM SOUTH – GARDEN STATE PARKWAY

Parkway North to exit 153 (Route 3 EAST) take Route 3 to the next
exit - Bloomfield Ave - ** SEE BELOW

FROM SOUTH – N.J. TURNPIKE

Turnpike North to exit 16W onto Route 3 West to Bloomfield Ave.
exit - ** SEE BELOW

*****BLOOMFIELD AVE. EXIT *****

At end of ramp, make a right and go past Styretowne Shopping
Center. Go half-way around circle (between Rick's Restaurant &
Getty station), you will still be on Bloomfield Ave. Go through next
traffic light (Jamie's Restaurant) – We are 2 ¼ blocks on the right –
we have a large parking lot (we're across from the Minit Mart &
DELTA station), before road curves.

FROM EAST – ROUTE 80:

Route 80-W to Route 19 South (toward Clifton) exit - follow Route
19 -- BEAR right when it splits with the Garden State Parkway –
you will now be on Broad Street. Go to 2nd light (Van Houten Ave.)
and make a left (Adam's Bagels & Texaco station). Go to 2nd light
(Mt. Prospect Ave.) and make a right (Walgreens). Make your next
left after railroad tracks (Brighton Road) and go to end. At traffic
light make a left onto Bloomfield Ave. (Jamie's Restaurant). We are
2¾ blocks on the right. We have a large parking lot (we're across
from the Minit Mart & DELTA station), before road curves.

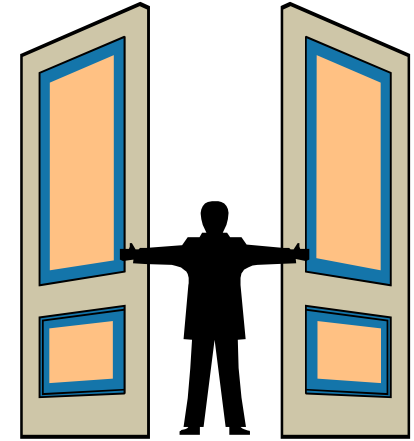
